and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof except as above
excepted - Witness my hand and seal the third day of Septem-
ber in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty
Eight and in the sixty third year of the sovereignty and Independence
