 beginning corner containing by Estimation One hundred and forty
 one and three fourth acres be it the same more less. Together
 with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
 singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Waters his heirs
 and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas
