

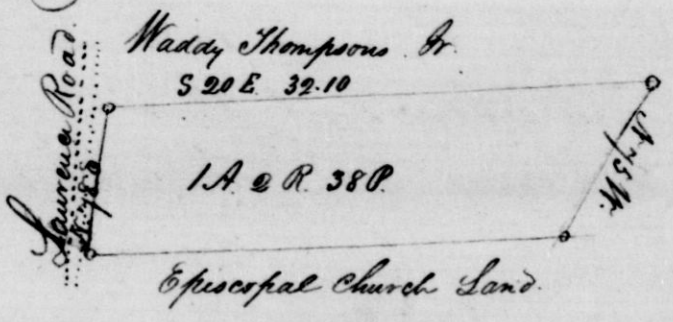

 Greenville District } of Greenville District and in the State aforesaid do for and  
 in consideration of the sum Eight hundred Dollars to me paid by W<sup>m</sup> C Bevens of Greenville District in the State aforesaid I have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said W<sup>m</sup> C Bevens All that lot or parcel of ground situate lying and being in the Corporation of Greenville adjoining lands of Waddy Thompson on the East C. C. Pinckney on the South & a lot called the Episcopal Church yard on the west & by the Laurence Road on the North and runs thus - Beginning on the beginning corner on the Laurence Road & runs with W<sup>m</sup> Thompsons line to 20 East 32<sup>nd</sup> 10. link. to a Post oak corner thence North 75 West to where it touches the land belonging to the Episcopal Church thence with Church line Back to the said Road thence along said Road to the beginning corner containing one acre Two Rods & Thirty Eight Perches as more plainly appears by the Plat herunto annexed dated April 2<sup>nd</sup> A. D. 1836 & surveyed by John C Hoyt having such shape & marks as there represented -

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; To Have and To Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said William C Bevens his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises unto the said William C Bevens his Heirs and Assigns against myself my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the 15 day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty nine and in the Fifty fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America -
