 sold, released and these presents do grant, bargain sell & release unto the said Isaac
 Hicks a certain piece of land which he now lives containing Fifty Acres more or less
 lying & being in Greenville District and State aforesaid on the head water of Rudy
 Fork Creek bounded by adjoining Lands of said Hicks & Isaac Cox & Wm Cox &
 A Cox. Commencing on a stake at the mouth of a stream against Isaac Cox
 Land and thence down the branch with said Cox's line to the corner on a
 Black oak thence along Abraham Cox's line to a white oak corner on the said
 stream thence down the stream aforesaid on a conditional line to the beginning
 state corner. the same being part of a tract originally granted to Alexander
 Waddell with all and singular the members hereditaments appurtenances
 and every part & parcel thereof. The rights & title whereof I said Samuel
 Hicks my heirs Executors & administrators unto the said Isaac Hicks his heirs
 Executors, administrators & assigns shall & will forever defend 16 March 1839

 fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by James Tucker of the State & District aforesaid have
 granted, bargained, sold and released & by these presents do bargain grant sell & release unto the
 said James Tucker a certain tract or parcel of Land containing One Hundred Acres
 more or less situated in the State and Dist aforesaid lying on the water of Beaver Dam
 Creek - Beginning at a stake on the Sourdau Road & running thence West across
 the creek & Greenville Road to a stake thence S 30 E 49.25 to a Red oak thence E to
 a stake on the said Sourdau Road & thence along said Road to the beginning corner

Together with all & singular the rights members, hereditaments & appurtenances thereunto
 belonging, or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the pre-
 mises before mentioned unto the said James Tucker his heirs & assigns forever. And I do
 hereby bind myself my heirs administrators & assigns to warrant & forever defend
 all & singular the said Premises unto the said James Tucker his heirs & assigns against
 myself my heirs & every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same
 or any part thereof. In witness whereunto I set my hand and seal this 30th day of
 July One thousand eight hundred and thirty six & of the Independence of the
 United States of America the Sixtyfirst - Signed sealed and delivered in
