Creek of Enore River beginning at a white oak 3x on the Long Branch & runs  
S 84 W. 2.50 to P.O. 3+ down thud on William Richards line N 5 E. 77.00 to Red Oak  
370 thud on Philip O Lester's Land N 74 W. 36.50. to a Rock + S. 83 W. 35.00 to a stake  
thud on John D Smiths line S. 74 E. 14.00. to a Red Oak. 3x0. dead on the south  
side of Rocky Creek thud down said Creek and the Factory Race at least 10 feet  
above or south of High Water mark. to the head of the race above the Factory.  
thud on William Bates line S 20 E. 45.00 to a small Holley 31+ on the long branch  
and down said branch to the beginning - also one half of all the machinery  
preparation &c. of all kind now on the premises - Together with all and singular  
the right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in anywise incident or appurtenant - To Have and To Hold the one half
