 of Greenville District State aforesaid, send Greeting. Whereas, by  
 virtue of sundry Writs of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held  
 for the District of Greenville tithed the day of March in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine at the suit of Samuel Clayton  
 vs. W. H. Houston, I Palmes to me directed commanding me that of the goods and  
 Chattels Lands and Tenements of John Palmes to levy the sum of one Hundred &  
 Ninety Dollars. damages & costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and  
 Tenements of the said John Palmes all that certain piece parcel and tract of land  
 containing two acres more or less. situate and being in the District of Greenville  
 on the Waters of Reedy River beginning on a Cussefras corner near the Spring  
 Church Eastwardly to to the top of the Ridge a stone corner thence Northward-  
 ly to a Red Oak corner thence westwardly to a Red Oak near the still House  
 Church Southwardly to a corner of said Palmes shop thence to the beginning  
 corner Together with the houses tanyard &c being the same Land tract or  
 parcel conveyed by William Houston to the said John Palmes. And where-  
 as the said Premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made  
 by virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed  
 to sale at Public vendue and purchased by Wesley Philips of the District
