To Have and To Hold the said piece or parcel or tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Wesley Philips his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said W Blasingame might, could, or ought to grant bargain, sell, the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid, and the said Writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise

(Viz) Beginning at a stake 3+ on Enoree Branch thence due south 8 Chs 30  
Ckts to a Pl. 3+ Perry's corner thence S 47 W 47 Ch. 50 links to a P. O. 3+ thence  
N 17 1/2 W 15 50 Ch to a chestnut 3+ on a Ridge thence N 8 W 23 Chs to a sweet  
Gum 3+ On Enoree Branch thence down the meanders of said branch to  
the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the Rights Mem-  
bers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or  
in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and To hold all and singular  
the premises aforesaid unto the said Wesley Philips his heirs and assigns forever
