 Hundred and Eleven acres whereon I now live, commencing
 on a Water Oak on Rocky Creek, running S 28. N. 30. to a chestnut
 thence S 46. E 17 to a Red oak bush, thence S 5. N. 19 1/2 to a P. Oak
 thence S 23. N. 21 1/2 to a Stake, thence S 7. E. 21 1/2 to a Red oak on
 Rocky Creek, thence up the meandering of the said Creek to
 the beginning corner. Bounding & Putting on the following
 Cauts viz. on John R. Smith, Jefferson Smith & Baylis Smith
 Together with all and singular the rights, members, ser-
 vitudes and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
 ing or in any way incident or appertaining to have and
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Elliott J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Adminis-
 trators to warrant and forever defend all singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Elliott J. Smith
 his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against
 every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
 or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand
 and Seal this 12th November 1833 and in the fifty eighth year
