Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Neilgors of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of Fifteen hundred dollars to me paid by Richard Barry of Spartanburgh District and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Richard Barry all that plantation or tract of Land on which I now live containing by hundreds thirty two acres more or less, situate on Goldens Creek of Enoree River beginning at a Maple 34, Josiah Neilgors corner on the Horns pen Creek and runs down said Creek to Goldens Creek, then up Goldens Creek to a Poplar 34 on the South Bank of said Creek about 20 yards below my Mill Dam, then S 9. N. 31. 2 to a Port Oak 34 then N 78. N 20 chains to a Persimmon 34 on Jones Spring branch then N. 31. N 18. 75 to a Spanish Oak 34 on Felix Green line, then on said line S 92. N 75 to a Stake, then N. 38. N. 75 to a White Oak 34 on the North side of Goldens Creek, then on Hartwell Lettin line to the 6006 branch & up said branch to its head, then S 19. 63 Ch to a Port Oak 34 dead, then S 70. N. 19. 75 to the Maggou Road then down said Road S 24. 6 17. 25, then S 71. 6 55. 50 to a P. Oak 34, then on Panister Stony line South 31. 50 to a Stake & Stone, then South 34. 6 20. chains to a P. O. 34, then N. 57. 6 34. 80 to a Hickory 34 then on Josiah Neilgors N. 14 1/2 N 37 chains to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights, moneys, rents, interest, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining.
