 the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by force
 or under them or either of them. To have and to hold
 the said Tract of Land with its hereditaments privileges
 & appurtenances to the said Lesse French his heirs & assigns
 to him and his only proper use and benefit the whole
