granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Lydia Hornbuckle and her heirs
and assigns forever a certain lot of land containing a half of an acre
situate in ^{the} town of Greenville near the Perditon road opposite the
residence of Mr. Hamison and now occupied by the said Lydia Hornbuckle
it being part of a lot of land purchased by me of Vardry M. Pe and
hath such bounds marks &c. as follows viz. Beginning at a stake
thence N 68 E. 147 feet to a stake thence N 22 W. 147 feet to a stake thence S 68
W. 147 feet to a stake thence S. 22 E. 147 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
unto the said Lydia Hornbuckle her heirs and assigns forever. And I do
herby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto to the said
Lydia Hornbuckle her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs
and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this

of land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on Branches
of Maple Creek of Reedy River adjoining lands of said James M. Daniel
on the North said Anderson Bray on the West and Lewis Rodgers on the South &
