 and at all times hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter into any or
 all the messuages lands or tenements of the said Robert Wilson
 and to take the said Negro man Elias into his custody and possession
 and the same to hold and detain to his own use and behoof (and
 his own proper goods and chattels) from hence forth and forever or the
 same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure, returning the over-
 plus if any should happen to be after paying the said sum of the
 thirteen hundred dollars with the lawfull interest, then according
 to the conditions of the bond aforesaid, unto the said Robert Wilson
 his Executors administrators or assigns. In Witness Whereof I the said

 day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight

 this 4 day of April 1806. — The conditions of the above obligation
 is such that if the above bounden Solomon Hauff do make or cause
 to be made unto said Higgins a good and Lawfull title to a certain
 tract of land, lying on the head of horse pen branches bound by
