Perry his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Joseph Powell of right had of in and to the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Benjamin F. Perry his heirs & assigns forever as fully and absolutely as if the said David Humming Sheriff might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writs of fieri facias or otherwise In witness whereof I the said David Humming have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty

 ash corner of Josephs Bartons land thence N 22 W 14 chs to a small
 Red Oak 3x N 54 E 5 chs to a Hickory 3x thence North 11 chs 50 links
 to an Ash at a Branch thence up the branch N 70 West 5 chs to a bend
