 singular the rights members to said premises before mentioned  
 unto the said Albertus Prince for his heirs and assigns forever  
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators  
 to warrant and defend all and singular said premises unto the  
 said Albertus Prince for his heirs and assigns against myself  
 my heirs and assigns and against every other person to whomsoever  
 lawfully claims the same or any part thereof of in witness whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this March 5<sup>th</sup> in the year of
