presents are such that if the said Long make or cause to be made unto the  
said James Cox his heirs or assigns full and complete payment of the above  
sum of 24 dollars 90cts with interest on or by the 25<sup>th</sup> of December next then  
the above Mortgage shall be null and void otherwise to remain in  
full force and virtue signed sealed and delivered in presence  
of B. M. Morris Thomas Long senr Seal

State of South Carolina Greenville District Personally came John Cox before me one of the  
Justices assigned to keep the peace in and  
for the S. District and makes oath in due form of law and saith on said  
Oath that he saw Thomas Long senr. assign seal and deliver the within  
mortgage for the uses and purposes within mentioned and that he also  
saw B. M. Morris assign the same as concerning witness with himself  
sworn and subscribed before me this 7<sup>th</sup> March 1840
