

State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Jacob Gyusa of the Greenville District State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen dollars to me in hand paid by Charles Boswell of the State and District aforesaid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell release confirm and convey unto the said Charles Boswell a certain piece of land it being a part of tract of Land containing 30 acres more or less situated lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of Facotet and the North of Saluda River. Beginning on on a stake thence a Constitutional line to a marked Chesnut thence to a marked Spanish Oak thence to a marked White Oak thence to the Original from thence to the stake at the Beginning corner it being part of certain tract of Land granted to John Wheeler together with all and singular Rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Charles Boswell his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles Boswell his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons who shall lawfully claim or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this thirty first day of May One thousand eight hundred and thirty eight Signed sealed and Delivered in the presence of us N. Goodlett of said District a certain tract or parcel of land situate and lying in the District aforesaid on the Middle branch of South Syger River it being the lower end of the tract whereon I Now live Beginning at a constitutional corner on a stake thence a direct line with a cross fence to Joseph McKinnays line including said cross fence thence along said McKinnays to James Goodletts line thence along said Goodletts line to Wilson Bartons line thence to the Beginning supposed to contain one hundred acres more or
