The State of South Carolina Agreement and bargain betwixt James Pickett Greenville District Land lord of the one part and Miss Belvanda Holcoube seamstress and domestic house servant of the other part. Witness it that the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube doth hereby agree to hire to live in the house with the said James Pickett And that the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube shall work and over see the said James house servants or slaves and also do all she can to save protect and shield the said James Pickett and his property from all wastage or wastfulness and also that the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube shall allways act and do as the said James may direct or require and for the faithfull and true performance of the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube as is above stated the said James Pickett shall pay the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube fifty dollars a year to be paid on the fourth day of October in each year Annually during of the time which the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube shall be and remain with the said James Pickett and also let it be further understood that if the said James and the said Miss Belvanda has not come to a full settlement & payment of the fifty dollars on the fourth day of October in each and every year or within three days after there it shall be considered and known by these presents that the said fifty dollars are paid to the said Miss Belvanda Holcoube for all the back years services as witness hereunto we do set our hands and affix our seals this fifth day of October 1838
