Then N 64 1/2 E 21 to a Water Oak 3 x on said Creek & down said Creek to the Beginning. Being the land conveyed to me by William Austin and John Braulet as appears by their deeds. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To. have and to hold all and singular the said premises with the Appurtenances unto the said Nathaniel King his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend the said premises unto the said Nathaniel King his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Peden all that tract of land lying on the waters of Rabunns Creek on the South side of the River, beginning on Stake in Old field 3 x 9.19 3/4 E. 50.00 to small Persimmon 3 x on Thomas J. Peden's land. Thence 75 1/4 E. 14.00 to Hickory 3 x 3 x 0 and Post Oak 3.0 on gate of Tom's Land. Thence N 14 3/4 W To Post Oak 3.0 and Pine 3 x 0 on Gas Mooney's Land and John J. Peden's 53.50 To Post Oak 3 x 0 Thence N
