to me paid by Samuel Ramsey of the said State and District have granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and release unto the said Samuel Ramsey part of the Plantation tract
of land where the said J. N. Bolling now lies bounded by Prody
River and lands belonging to Squire Calhoun. Peter Bolling and
D. S. C. Sullivan. Beginning at a Stone or Stake 3x near the Road
being Peter Bolling and Squire Calhoun's corner thence running
N. 69. E. 19. 70 to a Lower road 3x (below the Spring) then N. 87. E. 2.
