White Oak stump W-16-50 Spanish Oak N 70 W 70.00 Hickory the corner known by Wheelers clearing the corner of land known by Mr. Templeman's land bounded on the North side of by a Conditional line made by W. Linsey & Elijah Pruitt closing on the same line above named made by George Linsey and Wm Holcombe lying on the <sup>head</sup> waters of Pacolet

Part of the said tract of land known by the High Mountains with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Elijah Pruitt his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant forever
