 said line. thence N. 22. W. 17. 50 to a Post Oak 3x - thence South 81
 W. to Black Sack Corner. thence to a Branch and down said
 branch to the Creek to a Stake corner thence down the said
 Creek to a Chestnut corner 3x thence to the Beginning
 Together with all and singular the rights Members & creditaments
 and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise
 incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular
 the Premises before mentioned, unto the said Daniel Wheaton
 his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind the
 said William Honey his Heirs Executors & administrators
 to warrant & forever defend all singular the said Premises
 unto the said Daniel Wheaton his heirs and assigns against
