



Greenville Dist Know all men by these presents we William Morgan

 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or
 appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto said Dunahoo his heirs and assigns forever and I do here-
 by bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & forever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. B. Dunahoo
 his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
