 by Walton Stator in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, aliened
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Walton
 Stator. All that tract or parcel of land which was left by Will from
 Alexander McKinney Sen. deceased to Wizetta McKinney now Wizetta Serry
 the said land lying and being in the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid
 on the waters of North Fork of Saluda River known as the Adams Shosh
 tract containing Two Hundred & Ninety three acres more or less adjoining
 lands of John Philips Sen and others—

Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
 appertaining: So have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before
 mentioned, unto the said Walton Stator his heirs and assigns forever. And
 we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, executors and Administrators to warrant
 and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said Walton
 Stator his heirs and Assigns, against us and our heirs executors Adm^{rs} and
 Assigns from claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
