 the said Writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have been
 exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by John
 E. Williamson of the District of Greenville & State aforesaid
 for the sum of Five dollars being the highest sum
 that was bid for therefore. Now Know Ye that William M.
 Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said Writ of Fieri
 Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid
 and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and
 provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum
 of Five Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be
 paid by the said John E. Williamson the receipt and
 payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant
 bargain and sell unto the said John E. Williamson his
 heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece & parcel
 of land with its appurtenances and all the estate, right
 title and interest, which the said Master Nabours of right
 had of in and to the same.

To Have and to hold, the said piece parcel and tract of
 land with its appurtenances unto the said John E.
 Williamson his heirs and assigns forever as fully and
 absolutely as I the said William M. Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid
 might, could or ought, to grant bargain and sell the
 same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Fieri
 Facias or otherwise. In Witness whereof, I the said William M. Goodlett have
