Know all men by these presents that I Luke Compton
of the State and District aforesaid in Consider-
ation of the sum of one Ten Hundred and

ninetytwo dollars to me in hand paid by Jolly Bolling of the said State
and district aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jolly Bolling a Planta-
tion and tract of Land lying in the state and District aforesaid on
the waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda River it being the tracts of land that
I bought from William Williams containing one hundred and seventy
six acres a small tract I bought from Noah Cobb containing eleven
acres and the tract that I bought from John H Harrison containing
two hundred and fifty acres; beginning on a red Oak (being a
corner for the tract I got from Williams and the tract I got
from Harrison) thence running N 60 57 to a stake bounded by
land that the said Jolly Bolling got from Isham Harrison
thence S 60 W 5 to a stake thence N 45 W 30 to a stake thence S 60 W 16.
