Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said Writs of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of One thousand Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said James Farr the receipt and payment, whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said James Farr his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances, and all the estate right title and interest which the said John Farr of right had of in and to the same. To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances, unto the said James Farr his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said William M. Goodlett might lawfully or ought to grant bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said Writs of fieri facias or otherwise. In Witness whereof, I the said William M.
