Young a negro Slave named John about eight Years old To Have and to hold the said Negro Slave above mentioned unto the said Peterson Borrum in trust for my son James W. Young, during his natural life, and after his death in trust for the Children of the said James W. Young living at his death, & their heirs forever Provided always and these presents are upon this special trust and confidence I express condition, that he the said Peterson Borrum trustee as aforesaid, do permit & suffer me the said Mary Young to use & keep the said negro Slave & enjoy the proceeds of his labour during my natural life - without paying or yielding any thing for the same, or in respect thereto, and not otherwise - And from and after my death he the said Peterson Borrum Trustee as aforesaid shall or lawfully may have - hold & keep the said negro Slave & the proceeds of his labour for the sole use and benefit of my said son James W. Young, during his natural life, and after his death for the benefit of his Children then living & their heirs forever -
