


Moses Howard & Deed of Sale for 200 Acres of land

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Moses Howard of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred & Eighteen ²⁸/₁₀₀ Dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Howard of the State and district aforesaid I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel Howard a Part of that tract of land containing Two Hundred acres more or less surveyed to Jacob Davis & granted to him 30th October 1786 in the district and State aforesaid on both sides of Horsepen Creek and bounded by Stephen Howard Solomons Hays & Williams Road land together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Samuel Howard his heirs and assigns forever. And I Moses Howard do hereby bind myself My Heirs Executors adm^r and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said Samuel Howard his heirs Executors adm^r and assigns forever against himself his heirs Exor^s and adm^r and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of February One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and in the sixty first year of the Independence of the United States of America A.D. Eleven acres of the above described land excepted for Samuel Baldwin off of the lower end of the tract to include a part under fence = signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us

South Carolina Personally came William J.
