To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Barnet Statham his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, Executors, and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Barnet Statham his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Earle the wife of Henry M. Earle did this day appear personally before and upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare to me that she did at least seven days before such examination actually give her husband Henry M. Earle in executing the foregoing release and deed then & still does freely, voluntarily, and without any manner of compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce release and forever relinquish all her estate interest and inheritance in the premises mentioned in the foregoing release unto Barnet Statham and his heirs and assigns, and I do further certify that the said Mrs. Sophia J. Earle did declare that the said release was positively & bonafide executed at least seven days before such her examination now before me, Given under my hand and seal this fourth day of Jan'y 1842.
