 To Dudley Howell State of South Carolina Know all men by Greymille District Justice presents that I Hugh Bailey of the District and State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Dudley Howell of the Dist aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released unto the said Dudley Howell one certain tract of lands situate being & lying in the District and State aforesaid, on a branch called the meeting house branch Waters of Enoree River being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Uriah Conner Beginning on a Stake thence a S.W. Course to another Stake on Joseph Edwards corner thence a South course to a Stake thence with said Edwards line a West course to an Oak Stump thence a West course to a Stake on W^m Taylor's corner thence an East course with the said line to a Stake thence a North course to a White Oak on Dudley Howell's corner thence an East course to a White Oak thence a N. W. course with said Howell's line to the beginning containing fifty acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances.
