In consideration of which I the said Bradley do Mortgage all my lands on the waters of Tyger River bounded by lands of Joseph McKimney Wilson N. Goodlett Wm J Kelly and Benj Kelly together with the above lands I do Mortgage all my beds and furniture, also all my household and kitchen furniture to satisfy the above debt. If the said Bradley should pay the above debt this Mortgage to be null and void and of no effect, if not to remain in full force in Law given under my hands and seal this 15th July 1841 in presence of Amasa Underwood

Viz Beginning on a new Oak near Mr Wood land running thence S 55 W 65 ch. 111 to a pine thence N 15 E 45 chains to Hickory 111 O. thence N 55 W 73 chains to Black Oak 7 111 O. thence N 41 E 3 chains to Pine 111 O. thence N 85 E 30 chains to Red Oak 7 111 O. thence S 55 E 77 chains to the beginning Red Oak 7 111 O. containing Two Hundred and thirty two acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said James Woods his
