Trust Deed for Negro Slaves

James Mc Calwells & George Priest Brulee presents that J. John Robinson of Charleston in the State of South Carolina know all men by these

State aforsaid Factor for and in consideration of the  
loving affection which I have to my daughter Margaret Priest and my son in-  
law Mr. Edward T. Priest and their present and future issue and for other good cause  
more convenient moving and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand  
paid by the Trustees herein named, A Will granted bargained sold and delivered to and  
by these Presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto James Mc Calwells  
and George Priest ne. Trustees or the Survivor of them their executors and  
Administrators & assigns, the following Negro Slaves, to wit, Chloe and her  
two children, Sam and Johnny, also Amelia and her two children Mary  
and Charles. To these and to Held she said also negro Slaves with the fu-  
ture issue and increase of the Families unto the said James and the said  
George or the Survivor of them in Trust to and for the following uses trusts  
and purposes, that is to say in trust for the joint use, and benefit of the said  
Edward T. Priest and Margaret his wife for and during their natural life  
and at the decease of either of them, then in trust for the Survivor during  
his or her natural life and from and after the death of both the said Edward  
and the said Margaret then in trust for such child or children, the issue of  
the said Marriage as may be alive at the death of the Survivor of them  
to them their heirs, executors administrators as Tenants in Common, Share and  
Share alike, and in case all of the Children Should depart this life and there be  
no issue of the said Marriage, leaving either the said Margaret or the said Ed-  
ward alone surviving them, then in trust for the said Survivor, to him or her  
his or her heirs, executors administrators and assigns for ever free from all fur-  
ther and other trusts, And it is hereby expressly understood and agreed that  
the said Testimonees trust are to be permitted to have and receive and enjoy  
the said property and income or profits arising therefrom, without and free  
from any liability on the part of the said Trustees for the same, except so  
far as may come unto their possession either jointly or individually and  
to that intent only. And full power and authority is given and hereby given  
and granted to the said Trustees or the Survivor of them, his executors and  
administrators or assigns by and with the express and written Consent of the said  
<sup>and Margaret</sup> or the Survivor of them to sell and dispose of the said Negro Slaves  
or either of them and their future issue and increase and to execute sufficient  
Legal Tithes for the same and the proceeds arising from said sale again  
to reinvest and so again to sell and reinvest as often as may be required  
and the property in which it may be reinvested to hold in Trust subject to the  
same uses and purposes as are herein before declared. And in Case
