State of Tennessee County of Lincoln for divers good causes and considerations have this day made and appointed Shastaw Cordell of said State and District my true and lawful Attorney in Law and in my name to transact all and every thing of my business as respects sale and divisions of the Estate of my brother Daniel Marshall dec'd in Crawville District and State aforesaid myself being a legal heir with others to said Estate and do authorize him in my name place and stead to bring suit in my name either in Law or Equity also to sue and be sued please or impleaded in my name sustain and recover all damages for or against me and to do all other lawful acts and things whatsoever concerning said Estate as fully and in every respect as I myself could do were I personally present at the doing thereof - and have also given up to my said attorney certain powers which I have been inclined wish to use a power of atty from Abraham Jones and my sister Henry Jones Elizabeth Marshall and Mrs. A. Marshall all of the State of Tennessee and to manage the business of each and all as above empowered in Testimony whereof I have this 20 day of April 1834 set my hand and seal and date above written Signed and acknowledged before me
