Bee Street South by the one half of said square or Lot belonging to the Estate of Thomas Allen dec. now occupied by Elias Montgomery and West by Spring Street the same having been conveyed to me by George S. Townes Esq. Commissioner and Register in Equity under an order of the said Court bearing date the fifth day of August 1839 as the property of Thomas Allen dec. for a more particular description see Record Book E. pages 194. 195 & 196. Together with all and singular the rights, manors here ditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Emanuel Robinson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Emanuel Robinson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully
