

John R. Moore and wife Deed of Sale for 160 acres of Land

to John V. Bennet

South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that we John R. Moore and Sarah Moore his lawful wife of the State and District aforesaid, for and in the consideration of seven hundred Dollars to us paid in hand by John V. Bennet of the same State and District have bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said John V. Bennet his heirs or assigns a tract or parcel of Land in said District on Crippits Creek of Paddy River containing One hundred and sixty acres be the same more or less. Beginning at a rock on Hendersons line thence S. 25. W. 30. to a rock on Kuffs corner thence S. 63. E. 71. to a stone Thomasens corner, thence N. 25. E. 19. 83. to a stake Thomasens corner, thence N. 63. W. 34. 50. to a stake, thence on Coyses line N. 45. W. 37 to the beginning. A part of which Land being originally granted to Richard Lancaster, the other part originally granted to Peter Swinny, to have and to hold the same as above described to the said John V. Bennet his heirs and assigns forever, together with all rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or incident to the same, and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs and assigns to warrant and defend the said premises against ourselves our heirs and assigns, and against all persons legally claiming the premises or any part thereof, In witness we have hereunto set our hands and seals this fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two.
