Know all men by these presents that I Wm J Green of the State and District aforesaid mortgage release and bargain unto David Mc Davis of the District and State aforesaid his heirs or assigns that part of a tract of Land that lies on the south side of Greens creek, the whole of which tract the said Davis has this day conveyed to me by deed, the said tract contains three hundred acres more or less, and is bounded by lands of Smiths Red Whitten Ward and others (the particulars see Green from Davis to Green) to have and to hold the above described Land under mortgage to him the said David Mc Davis for and in consideration of Two Hundred Dollars. The condition of the above obligation is such that if the aforesaid Wm J Green shall on or before the expiration of Two years from the date hereof pay or cause to be paid to the said David Mc Davis Two Hundred Dollars, then this mortgage to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. Know all men by these presents that I W. J. Green of the District and the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me paid by Roger Loveland and W Blasingame of the District in the State aforesaid I have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said R Loveland and William Blasingame all of two tracts of Land lying on both sides of Green Creek waters of south Picolet River adjoining Lands of S R Whitten J Ward B Pruitt J Reed and W Barnett. The one tract conveyed to me from David Davis (being all the Lands conveyed to him from Stephen Johnson) the other tract conveyed to Abraham Green from John Barnes (which I purchased from the said Barnes) and the said Abraham Green having never paid one cent for the same, it being the same Lands conveyed to the said John Barnes from Robert Grodgon or Martin Oat see Records in Clerks Office (containing in all Four Hundred and fifty (450) acres, be the same more or less, together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold, all and singular the premises beforementioned unto the said Loveland and Blasingame their heirs and assigns forever
