his wife (late Nancy Boswell) for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to us paid by Benjamin Boswell and John Boswell all of the said State and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Benj^m Boswell and John Boswell their heirs and assigns forever all our and each of our interests of in or to a certain tract of Land situate in said District on Mush Creek of South Tyger River, containing Two hundred and sixty eight acres, it being a tract of Land of Land of which Samuel Boswell deceased died seized and possessed the said deceased being the former husband of the said Nancy McKinney And we do hereby fully invest in the said Benjamin Boswell and John Boswell their heirs and assigns forever our aforesaid claim which is one third of the value of the said tract of Land and do hereby forever relinquish the same for the consideration aforesaid, In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 17th day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one Signed sealed and delivered
