William Edwards. Deed of Sale for 245 Acres of Land 85

To Ethel Holtzclaw. The State of South Carolina  Greenville District  Know all men by these presents that I

William Edwards of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Ethel Holtzclaw have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said E. Holtzclaw all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on Enoree River the north side the same being a tract of Land as sold by Edmund Middle to the said William Edwards Beginning on a small dogwood originally a blackjack running N. 12 3/4 W. 27.75 to a Black gum originally a Red oak thence N. 53 3/4 W. 52.25 to a P. O. XIII thence S. 27. W. 10.75 to a Black gum on a branch next Gauble thence upon the meanders of the branch to the River thence S. 19 1/2 E. 11.25 to a small chestnut thence S. 61. E. 3.18. P. O. XIII thence S. 54 1/2 E. 4.32. to pine thence S. 58 1/2 E. 14.64 to a maple on the bank of the river thence down the meanders of the river to the mouth of Hollands Spring branch thence up the meanders of the branch about 3.50 to thence S. 84. E. 11.25 to a Red oak thence N. 28 3/4 E. 9.14. to the beginning reference to a plat made by Washington Taylor Decr. 14th 1841 will more fully appear containing two hundred and forty five acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights, members, tenements and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident and appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ethel Holtzclaw his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Holtzclaw his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this eighteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one and in the sixty sixth Year of the Sovereignty & independence of the United States of America.
