And I do hereby guarantee to the said George Puist this assigns that the said George Patten at the date hereof has not & can claim no discount to either of said notes on account of my indebtedness to him or on account of the thousand Dollars purchased by him from me for which said notes were given also that the said property contained in the within mortgage conveyed by me to said George Patten on the 21st April 1841 was legally vested in me in my own right free from all incumbrances or liens whatsoever at the time of the said sale & that it prove or be made to appear otherwise I bind myself to the said George Puist this assigns to be responsible for & pay the amount of loss or deficiency which may be incurred on account of my above guarantee.
