E. 95. to a stake by a chestnut, thence N. 40 E to a Pine knot corner made on the dividing line between John Buchanan & Lindsey Hudson, thence along dividing line to a stake, thence N. 10 west 31 to straws Hudsons corner thence, 80. E. to a Stake corner, thence 12 to a Stake thence S. E. S. 40 W. 67 to the beginning corner, It being part of a tract of Land containing six hundred forty acres Granted to John Buchanan from under the hand of his excellency William Moultrie Esq. bearing date the 6th of May 1786, Together with all & singular the rights, Members, Hereditaments & Appurtenances, to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining; I have and do hold, all & singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Edmund Waddell his heirs & assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend, all & singular the said Premises unto the said Edmund Waddell his heirs & assigns against me & my heirs & against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand & Seal this Eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty two, and in the sixty seventh year of the Independence of the United States of America
