Twenty acres of land more or less lying in the district aforesaid on the water of Ready River being part of a tract of Land originally granted to John Pyle and signed by his excellency William Moultrie on the 1st of Sept 1786. the said twenty acres of land more or less is laid out unto the said William H. Ashmore as follows, viz, Beginning on the line near Mr Pollard (dece'd) house, thence eastwardly to W^m H. Ashmore's corner, on Duns line, thence along Duns line, to the branch thence up the meander of the branch to the beginning including twenty acres of land, more or less together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant, To Have & To Hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W^m H. Ashmore, his heirs and assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant forever defend, all and singular the said twenty acres of Land more or less with the premises unto the said W^m H. Ashmore his heirs & assigns and all and every other person or persons, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand Seal in presence of us this ninth day of April 1842
