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E. P. Jones of South Carolina Know all men by these presents, That I do hereby give, sell, bargain, sell & release unto the said Thomas P. Butler, All that piece or parcel of land situate near the Village of Greenville on the Buncombe road nearly opposite the residence of Major C. D. Caste, Beginning at a stake near the said Buncombe road, and runs north 37° W. 6 chs 32 links to a stake near the said road thence to 53° N. eight chs to a small P. Oak, thence S. 37° E. six chs 32 links to a small black Oak, thence N. 53° E. eight chs to the beginning, containing five acres and eight poles by estimation be the same more or less it being the same piece or parcel of land conveyed to me by Vardry McBee Esquire by Deed dated the 21st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty nine (1839) Together with all & singular the rights, Members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident, or appertaining, To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas P. Butler his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas P. Butler his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty three & in the 67th year of the independence of the United States of America Signed, Sealed & delivered in the presence of
