hand paid by Francis Benson of the State and District aforesaid
except whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold,
leased and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,
release and convey and confirm unto the said Francis Benson
and assigns forever a certain tract, piece or parcel of land, situate
lying and being in the State and District aforesaid containing two
acres, more or less, Beginning on a stake on Enoree thence S. 1. W. 1/4
on F. Benson's line near where I reside thence S. 65. E. to a Black Oak
the West side of the road near the fork thence S. with said Road to
Oak near Lynches Store house thence N. 76. E. 19. 20 links to a Post Oak
N. S. E. 5 to a Stake, thence N. 65. E. 10. 10 to a maple on a branch, thence
branch N. 17. E. 15 to two pines, thence due north 12. 90, to a Stake, thence
in easterly of Enoree to the beginning, Together with all singular
members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said land herein
described, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, and
and to hold, all and singular the said premises unto the said
Benson her heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the
title unto the said Francis Benson her heirs and assigns to warrant & defend
the said premises unto the said Francis Benson her heirs and assigns and
myself my heirs executors or administrators I against every other person
