 To Greenville District these presents that I  
 Samuel S. Green Elijah Holtzclaw, of the State and District do  
 hereafter for and in consideration of the sum of one  
 hundred and thirty three dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel S. Green  
 for a certain parcel or tract of land, containing by estimation fifty four and  
 a half acres, the same being part of a tract of land originally granted to Joseph  
 McLaughlan and is now held by legal conveyance by Elijah Holtzclaw,  
 Situate in Greenville District on Princess Creek the above named forty four  
 acres and a half being a part thereof. Beginning on a Red Oak x s,  
 Running thence N. 40 W. 24 Chs and 50 links on Samuel S. Green's line to  
 a poplar s x, on a Branch. Thence N. 60 E. 16 Chs 50 up said Branch to a  
 Maple s x on Elijah Holtzclaw's land, Running thence S. 51 E. 21. 30. to  
 a Stake still binding on S. Holtzclaw's land, Running thence S. 51 W. 21.  
 Chs to the Beginning Corner, this last line binding on Hugh Bailey and Wm  
 Taylor. Reference being had to the plat thereof, together with all and sin-  
 gular, the rights, Members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto  
 belonging, To Have and To Hold, all and singular the said parcel or  
 tract of Land, to the said Samuel S. Green, his heirs, executors, adminis-  
 trators and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, execu-  
 tors, administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the said Green  
 and the said Samuel S. Green his heirs, executors, administrators and  
 assigns, against myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, as  
 well as all other persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part  
 thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed  
 my seal this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord 1837.
