Seadiah Cook To James Woodside  
 State of South Carolina Greenville District  
 This Indenture, made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1843, between Seadiah Cook of the one part, and James Woodside Sum of the other part, Whereas

the said James Woodside at the special instance and request of him the said Seadiah Cook hath become bound together with him the said Seadiah Cook unto Barnett Cleveland of the District aforesaid in a Note or bond of four hundred dollars bearing date from about the first of April eighteen hundred & forty one, which same monies being the proper debt of the said Seadiah Cook, and the said James Woodside being only security for the said Seadiah Cook and at his request as aforesaid he the said Seadiah Cook to secure him the said Woodside against the same hath agreed to sell and in plain and open market, deliver unto the said James Woodside of the District aforesaid the following property, viz. Three Negroes, Jude, Sarah & Jim, To have and to hold, all and singular the said property unto the said James Woodside, his executors, Administrators, & assigns forever, Provided nevertheless, and it is expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said Seadiah Cook his executors and Administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Barnett Cleveland his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators or assigns the full sum of the above named four hundred dollars and save harmless the said James Woodside from all charges costs & damages that may arise from the same at all times then the above bill of Sale and every article or thing therein shall cease and be utterly void or else remain in full force & virtue, Given under my hand & seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y 1843
