one hundred dollars to me paid by John McClure of Green-
ville District, State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell & release
unto the said John McClure, all that tract of Land, lying and
being in the District of Greenville on both sides of Mill Creek, a
branch of So. Facolt's River, Beginning at a pine running
thence North 40 W. to a N.O. thence S 50 W 27 Ch. to a Chestnut
Stump, thence So. 40 East to a small Pine,, Emorys corner, thence
to the Beginning. Containing one hundred acres, be the same
more or less, Together with all and singular, the rights, members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises belonging-
in any view incident or appertaining. To have and To hold,
all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said
John McClure, his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby
bind myself, my heirs Executors and administrators, to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the premises, unto the
said John McClure, his heirs and assigns, against myself
my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,
Witness my hand and Seal this 10th day of April 1835
