 Sevelles, Thomas Carter, J. Jamison et al - And whereas, the
 said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me
 made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned
 have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by
 Hewlet Sullivan of the District of State aforesaid for the sum of
 seven hundred & seventy Dollars being the highest sum that was
 bid therefor, Now know ye, that J. W. Goodlett Sheriff
 aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to
 me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute
 in such case made and provided and for and in consideration
 of the said sum of seven hundred and seventy dollars to me in
 hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Hewlet Sullivan
 the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have
 granted bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain
 and sell unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his heirs and assigns fore-
 ever, the said tract, piece or parcel of land, with its appurten-
 ances, and all the estate right title and interests which the said
 John E. Williamson of right had of, in and to the same, To
 Have and To hold, the said piece, parcel & tract of Land, with
 its appurtenances unto the said Hewlet Sullivan, his heirs and
 assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as the said W. M. Goodlett
 Sheriff aforesaid, might could or ought to grant, bargain and sell the
 same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of fieri
 facias or otherwise. In witness whereof I the said W. M. Goodlett
