

Edward Gantt his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, do covenants, promise and agree to and with the said Richard H. & Chas. B. Stone their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, by these presents, that if default shall happen to be made of or in payment of the said sum of money as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of the said note so as to make the said Richard H. & Chas. B. Stone liable for the payment of the above mentioned money that then and in such case, it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Richard H. & Chas. B. Stone their heirs, administrators, attorneys or agents from time to time and at all times hereafter, peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messuages, lands or tenements of the said Edward Gantt, and to take the above mentioned four Negro men slaves, Caesar, Jack, Wesley & Sam, into the custody and possession, and the same to hold and detain to their own use and behoof, as their own proper goods & chattels from thenceforth and forever or the same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure, retaining the overplus, if any should happen to be, after paying the whole amount of the note and interest together with the costs, if any should occur unto the said Edward Gantt his heirs, administrators, or assigns. In witness whereunto I the said Edward Gantt have hereunto set my hand and seal this the nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three and in the sixty seventh year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America. Ward hath given and granted, and by these presents doth grant unto the said Isaac I. Ward his heirs and assigns one hundred & forty acres of land of the North side of the tract of land wherein I the said Robert Ward now live, containing one hundred
