Greenville and State aforesaid, in consideration  
of the sum of three hundred Seventy five Dol  
lars to use in hand paid by Robert Scott, of Greenville District and  
State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Robert Scott,  
all that plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and  
seventeen acres, more or less, situated in Greenville District, lying  
on the waters of horse Creek of Rudy River, surrounded by lands  
of Joseph McCullough & Anna Thumate. Beginning on a  
white Oak 3x. running thence South 5 W. 16.50 to a stake 3x. thence  
N 66 E. 33.80 to a Black Oak 3x. thence S. 1 chain to a stake  
3x. on the branch, thence down said branch, to a stake 3x. at  
the mouth, thence up little horse Creek to a maple 3x. thence  
up the Spring Branch to the Beginning. Together with all and  
singular, the rights, members, Hereditaments, & appurtenances, to the  
said premises, belonging or in any wise appertaining or incident  
To Have and To Hold, all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said Robert Scott, his heirs and assigns  
forever, And we do jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs  
Executors and administrators to warrant & forever defend all and  
singular, the said premises unto the said Robert Scott, his heirs  
and assigns against ourselves, our heirs and every other person or  
persons, whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof, witness our hands & Seals this 11<sup>th</sup> day of  
January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
forty two and in the sixty sixth year of the Independence of  
the United States of America - Signed sealed and delivered
