Mathew Wynn late of the District of Greenville  
by his last will and testament bequeathed  
to his wife Susannah Wynn during  
her life the land and plantation whereon he lived, & directed  
at the death of his wife, the land to be sold and the money  
arising from the sale thereof to be divided between all of  
his children and by another clause in said will he nomi-  
-nated and appointed his wife and two sons, John Wynn and  
Thomas Wynn the said to execute the said last will and  
testament, and some time after the date of the said last-  
will and testament he departed this life and after the death  
of the testator John Wynn & Thomas Wynn two of the Executors  
departed this life leaving Susannah Wynn sole surviving  
executrix who also departed this life about the tenth of March  
A.D. 1843, and on the third day of April A.D. 1843, adminis-  
-tration with the will of Mathew Wynn annexed was granted  
to Roger Loveland by John Watson Esqr. Ordinary of  
Greenville District, Now know all men by these presents

Wynn resided at the time of his death, beginning at  
a Black Gum ox. at the head of a branch thence S. 73<sup>o</sup>  
E. 19. Chs to a Stake ox. near a pond thence N. 20 E. 45. 30
